

Trial Flights

1. A fully rated instructor must supervise trial lesson flying
2. Trial lessons should only be flown in appropriate weather conditions
Do not:
 - Launch into cloud
 - Launch in rain, or if the flight is likely to be in flown in rain
 - Launch with rain/snow/ice on the gliders flying surfaces
 - Launch with misted canopy
3. Any of the following may be reason to cancel or stop flying:
 - The wind is turbulent (varying by more than 10 kts)
 - The wind is strong (> 20 kts)
 - Cloudbase is less than 1200 Feet
 - Flight visibility is less than 5km
 - Launching above more than 4/8th cloud
4. No aerobatics to be performed on trial lessons
5. Whatever the experience level of the trial lesson pilot the instructor must do all the flying below 500ft and from the low-key position.
