

Tug pilot qualifications

1. Minimum gliding qualification – Silver C, and in current gliding practice.
2. 100 hours power flying
3. Evidence of tail dragger experience.
4. Approval by CFI

Annual renewal of tug pilot qualification

1. Glider checks with CFI or deputy annually.
2. A minimum of 5 hours solo gliding annually.
3. Presentation of log book and medical certificate to CFI annually.
4. The year to run from 1st January to 31st December each year.
5. Currency checks as for glider pilots.
