- It is for highlighting and sharing personal achievements
 - Record club highlights and the joys (and sometimes tribulations) of gliding, giving a good insight into the ethos and companionship which surrounds it
 - Promote The Park and gliding in general, and make the idea of joining the club or taking up gliding attractive to an outsider
 - And of course it is excellent for passing on information to club members.

 - It is **not** be a place to air grievances
 - It is **not** the place for lobbying for change
 - It is **not** the place for any form of insult or disrespect, either collective or personal.

Will it make **anyone** uncomfortable, argumentative or annoyed, or put the club or gliding in a bad light? **Leave it OUT!**

Posts on the Club Blog should be enthusiastic, informative and possibly humorous. They should attempt to make the club and gliding attractive to members and 'outsiders' alike. Contentious issues, club politics or grievances should not be aired. The posts should be factually accurate. No personal or collective disrespectful or insulting language will be tolerated.
