Trophy	Description	Winner 2023
<b>Gordon Mealing trophy</b>	Presented by the committee to the person deemed to have contributed most to the functioning of the club	Adam Sanders
<b>Keevil cup</b>	Highest National Ladder points. Open to all gliders and pilots	Alastair MacGregor
<b>Park cup</b>	Highest National Ladder points in a non-powered glider, or with the engine not operable	Steve Lambourne
<b>Distance trophy</b>	For the longest handicapped flight from The Park	Mark Player
<b>Club two-seater trophy</b>	For the highest scoring cross country flight in a club two-seater. Awarded to both pilots	<i>New award for 2024</i>
<b>Club glider trophy</b>	Highest National Ladder points in a privately owned or club glider, up to the handicap of the club Astir JKW	Tim Brunskill
<b>Junior trophy</b>	The pilot who has achieved the most in the year, and is under age 25	James Farr
<b>Dick Hadlow trophy</b>	Presented by the CFI for airmanship. To the most deserving Junior member	Reuben Pickard
<b>100K trophy</b>	Fastest handicapped speed around declared or club triangle scored as 100-200 km with any deductions for height loss or turnpoint type taken into account. The triangle must qualify as a FAI 28% triangle but may use additional turnpoints according to BGA Ladder rules (i.e. currently qualifying for a shape factor of 1.08). The task must be completed.	Mark Player
<b>Height award</b>	Greatest height gain	Graham Hoile
<b>Almost did it trophy</b>	For the best try	Tom Hogarth

All trophies except the Almost did it, Junior and Dick Hadlow are scored under National Ladder rules.

Only flights flown in the calendar year from The Park, Interclub League or organised club expeditions in the UK are eligible for scoring.
